Please read with your child every day if at all possible. As well as the ability to decode words, it is essential to build a child's fluency in reading so they are able to recall words quickly and accurately. This enables children to gain an understanding of what they have read. Re-reading their books over will help support this.

Homework will continue to be set weekly, set on a Friday and should be handed in by the following Wednesday. We very much encourage children to take responsibility for completing this, however, welcome any home support. If your child is struggling, please contact your child's teacher and we will of course support in school. There is an expectation that in addition to homework set, children in year 2 will practice their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

When the children have a PE session, they should come to school in their PE kit.
