- I know what the word climate means.

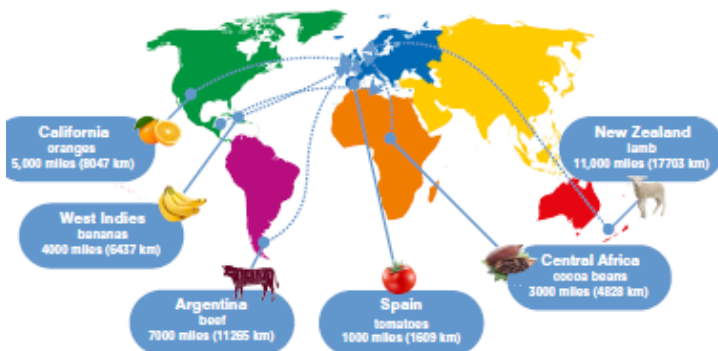
OVERVIEW

International trade is the exchange of goods and services between countries.

- Food – different climates allow different types of food to be grown.
- Natural resources – all the land, forest, energy sources and minerals existing naturally. Humans are reliant on natural resources for survival.
- Tourism – involves people travelling between countries for a holiday or leisure

Countries can earn money by exporting food and natural resources also tourism helps to generate income.
