### WHAT TO BRING

	1 Bath Towel (+ 1 extra towel if possible as a spare)	
	Toilet Bag containing – Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, Shower Gel, Shampoo, Flannel, Hairbrush etc. – <b>NO AEROSOLS</b>	
	Hair Bobbles/Ties (for long hair)	
	Night Clothes	
	Socks (extra pair for wellingtons) and Underwear (extra pair in case)	
	T-shirts, Shirts (at least 1 with long sleeves) (3 or 4 maximum)	
	Sweatshirts/Jumpers (2 or 3)	
	Pair of Bottoms (trousers/joggers/waterproofsetc.) (2 or 3)	
	<b>Warm Clothes for sitting around the campfire</b>	
	Waterproof Coat (as well as Trousers if you have them)	
	Shoes, Trainers for activities (a second pair of trainers or plimsolls would be useful), Wellington Boots or Sturdy Shoes. <b>Shoes must be closed toe</b>	
	Large Plastic Bag for Dirty Clothes (e.g. a Bin Liner)	
	Hat, Sunglasses and Suncream	
	<b>Medication</b> – Inhalers, with details of when to take. Any other Medication in a named envelope/bag with dosage instructions	

#### OTHER USEFUL ITEMS

	Small Bag or Rucksack	
	Special Toy (not big)	
	NO PHONES or Electrics Games	
	NAMED Water Bottle	
	MAXIMUM of £5 which can be spent in the shop – this must be in a named envelope (optional)	
	Small sensible amount of sweets or goodies
