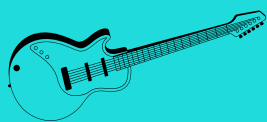

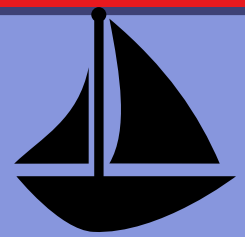

We are looking forwards to our Nene Park trip in the last week of term. Please return your form by Tuesday 9th July if you haven't already. Thank you.



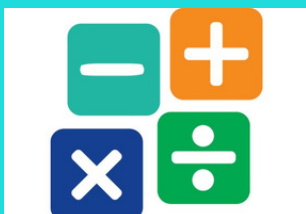
Year 6 Sailing
